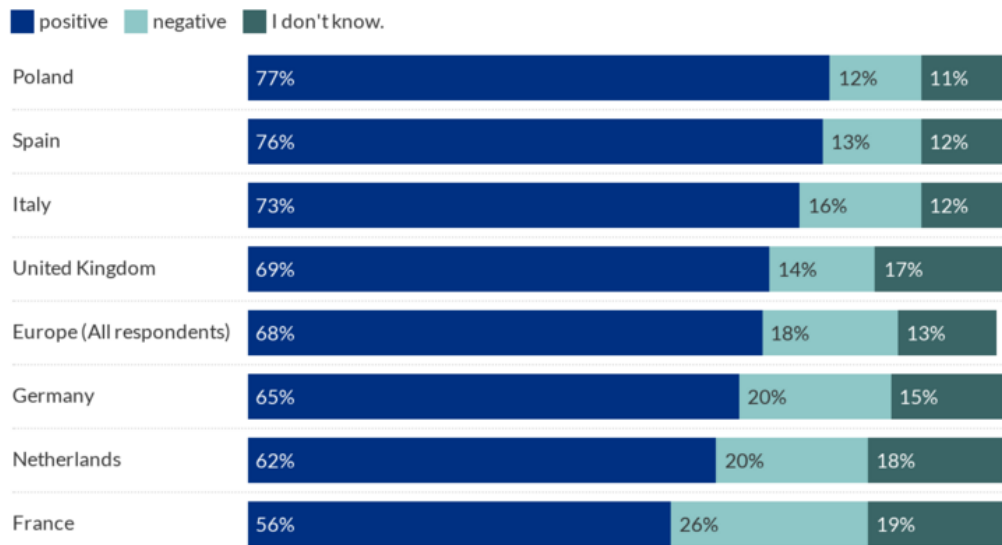

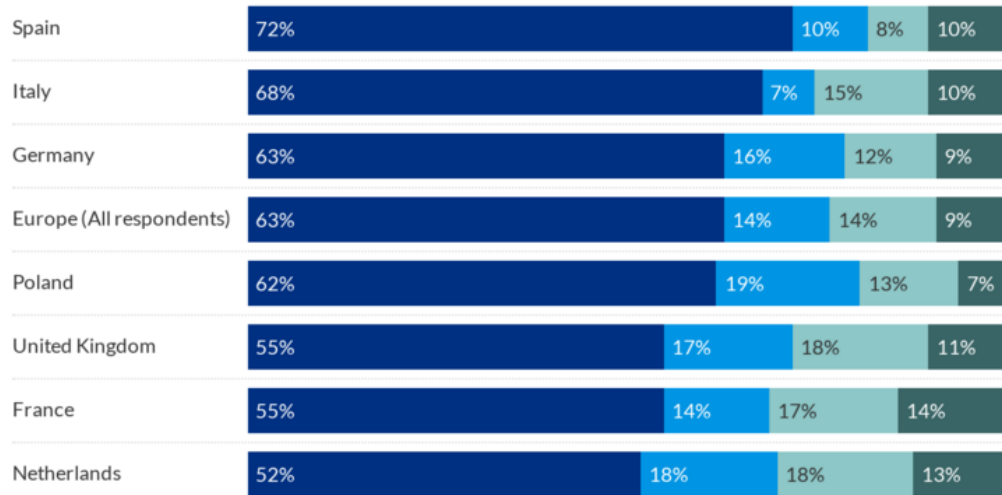
When you think about the next 15 years, do you think that technological innovation/digitalisation will have a positive or negative impact on your life?

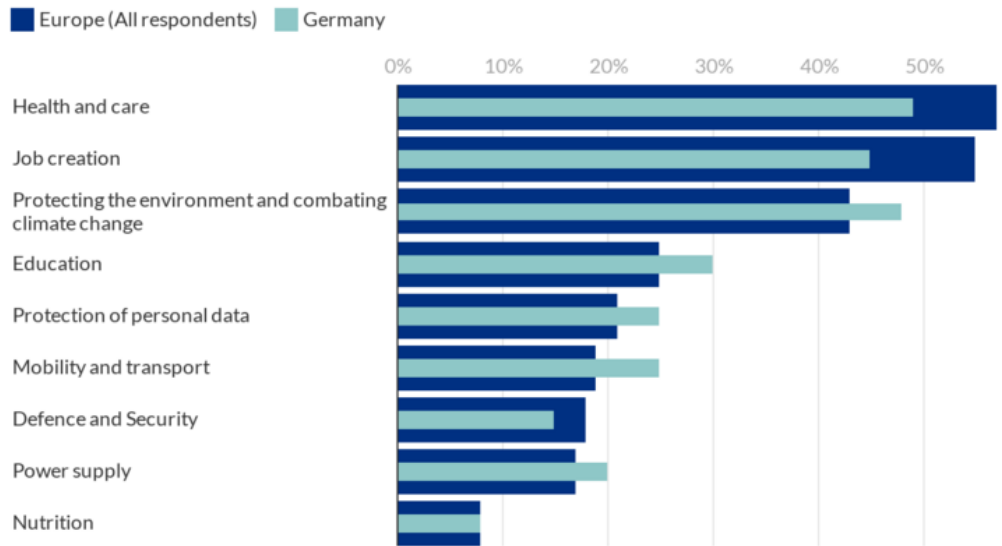
