The Citizens' Dialogue was conducted by the European Commission in cooperation with the Bertelsmann Stiftung








## The future of Europe: what holds us together?

Citizens discuss cooperation in the border region, EU refugee policies and EU social policies. The set-up involved discussions in small groups followed by exchange with Martin Selmayr, Secretary-General of the European Commission as well as members of the European Parliament and mayors.


114 German, Austrian and Czech citizens, response rate to questionnaires: 93%, 106 questionnaires.



According to participating citizens, the first German-Austrian-Czech Citizens' Dialogue was a great success: over 90 per cent gave the Citizens' Dialogue the rating "very good" or "good".

- "Excellent work by the moderators and interpreters."




### Citizens were very appreciative of the opportunity to discuss important cross-border topics.

"Good overview of the situation on the other side of the border, new experiences."


"Interesting discussions with interesting people. New ideas for ordinary citizens."

80% of citizens rated the direct discussions with politicians in the discussion sessions "good" to "very good". Martin Selmayr's participation, in particular, was praised several times.
